

Announcement of International Collaborative Research Program 2023

The Research Center for Development of Far-Infrared Region, University of Fukui (FIR UF), has started the International Collaborative Research Program from FY2017. This program aims to support the development of the far-infrared region research through the international personnel exchanges and studies, being conducted at the FIR UF in a wide array of fields, including the development of light sources, applied research, and research and development of new technologies. FIR UF are now accepting proposals for the FY 2023 (August 2023 – March 2024).

How to apply

Please send an application form (Form 1) through the members of the FIR UF faculty after setting a research theme and organizing a research team. The deadline for applications is **June 16, 2023**.

Procedures

Term: Within one year (from the date of the acceptance notice to March 31, 2024)
In principle, collaborative research shall be performed approximately for two weeks at the FIR UF.

Venue: Research Center for Development of Far-Infrared Region, University of Fukui (FIR-UF)

Financial Support: Expenses will be available until the end of January 2024. The total amount of support for the international collaboration will be limited to 200,000JPY (Asian, Oceania and other regions nearby Japan) and to 300,000JPY (Europe, North America and other regions far from Japan) depending on the researcher's country of residence.

The number of recipients is limited to three or four because of the limited amount of available budget in this fiscal year. Notice of the selection will be by the end of July, 2023.

Report

Recipients are expected to submit a one-page research report in A4 sheet on or before the set deadline (March 31, 2024).
