○ Procedure

Term: Within one year (from the starting date to March 31 of next year)

Venue: The Research Center for Development of Far-Infrared Region, University of Fukui Collaborative research will be performed approximately for two weeks at the FIR UF.

Financial Support: A part of travel expenses and accommodation fee will be covered.

Report: You are expected to submit a one-page research report in A4 sheet.

Regarding the **International Collaborative Research Program 2018**, the period for research collaboration will be **from July of 2018 to March of 2019**. You should apply for the program by **March 31, 2018**, as there is a limit for the number of entries. Additional call for applications might be possible when we can afford to accept more participants.
